

Cookie Policy

1. What Are Cookies

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work, to improve user experience, and to provide analytics and marketing information. This cookie policy (this "Cookie Policy") explains how Seyff and our service providers use cookies on seyff.co (the "Site").

2. Categories of Cookies We Use

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the Site to function. They enable basic features such as navigation, secure areas, and form submission. The Site cannot function properly without these cookies, and they cannot be disabled in our systems.

Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with the Site by collecting information anonymously. They include cookies set by our website host (Wix) and may include cookies set by Google Analytics or similar services. You may opt out using your browser settings or the cookie banner on the Site.

Functionality Cookies

These cookies allow the Site to remember choices you make (such as language) and provide enhanced features. They may be set by us or by third party providers whose services we have added to our pages.

Marketing and Advertising Cookies

If used, these cookies track your browsing habits to deliver advertising relevant to you and your interests. They may be set by advertising partners, including Meta Pixel and LinkedIn Insight Tag. You can manage these cookies through the cookie banner on the Site and through your browser settings. Seyff currently does not run paid advertising; if we begin to do so, this Cookie Policy will be updated.

3. Third-party Cookies

Our Site uses several third-party services that may set cookies on your device:

- Wix: as our website host, Wix sets cookies to operate the Site and provide analytics. See Wix's Cookie Policy at [wix.com](https://www.wix.com/privacy/cookie-policy).
- Google Analytics: if enabled, Google Analytics sets cookies to provide visitor analytics. See [policies.google.com](https://policies.google.com/technologies/ads).
- Mailchimp: when you interact with a Mailchimp embedded form, Mailchimp may set cookies. See mailchimp.com/legal.

- Vimeo or YouTube: if we embed videos, those platforms may set cookies when you load the video.

4. [Managing Cookies](#)

You may control cookies in the following ways:

- Cookie banner: when you first visit the Site, you will be presented with a cookie banner allowing you to accept or decline non-essential cookies.
- Browser settings: most browsers allow you to view, manage, delete, and block cookies. Consult your browser's help section for specific instructions.
- Opt-out tools: you may opt out of Google Analytics tracking using the Google Analytics Opt-out Browser Add on.

If you disable cookies, some features of the Site may not work as intended.

5. [Do Not Track](#)

Some browsers transmit a Do Not Track signal. Because there is no industry standard for handling these signals, our Site does not currently respond to them. We honor opt out requests through the cookie banner and through opt out tools described above.
