

# Accessibility Statement

Effective May 27, 2026.

## 1. Our Commitment

Seyff is committed to providing a website, studio, and gallery program that is accessible to the widest possible audience, including people with disabilities. We strive to align our digital and physical experiences with applicable accessibility standards, including the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Title III and the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 Level AA.

## 2. Website Accessibility

Our website is built on Wix, which provides accessibility features including keyboard navigation, screen reader compatibility, alt text for images, and color contrast tools. We are actively working to identify and address accessibility issues. If you encounter any barrier on our website, please contact us and we will work to remediate the issue.

## 3. Physical Accessibility

- The Seyff studio is located at 247 Water Street, Unit 307, Brooklyn, NY 11201, on the third floor of an elevator served building.
- The studio entrance, restroom (shared with the floor), and class area are accessible to wheelchair users.
- Service animals are welcome.
- Seating, easel heights, and table heights can be adjusted to accommodate attendees who use mobility devices or who prefer to paint while seated.
- Lighting may be adjusted to accommodate visual sensitivities; please notify us at booking.
- If you require ASL interpretation, large print materials, or any other accommodation, please contact us at least 14 days in advance of your session so we can arrange it.

## 4. Sensory Accommodations

Our studio is designed as a sensory calibrated space, with warm lighting, low ambient music, and curated scents. We understand that some attendees may be sensitive to scent, sound, or light. We will work with you to reduce or eliminate any of these elements for your session on request.
